## Strongsville Republicans endorse Zubek for City Council

STRONGSVILLE, Ohio – Anthony P. (Tony) Zubek, a candidate for council-at-large in Strongsville, has received the endorsement of the Strongsville Republican Club. Zubek, who recently won the endorsement of the Republican Party of Cuyahoga County (RPCC), said his candidacy is based on the city's need for fresh, experienced leadership on City Council.



The Strongsville club announced its endorsement this week.

The endorsements of the local Strongsville club and the county party confirm their confidence that Zubek, a management consultant, will provide that important, fresh approach to the leadership of the growing community.

"The endorsement of the RPCC Central and Executive Committees demonstrated faith in my abilities by the grass roots members of the party," Zubek said. "The endorsement by the citizens of Strongsville gives local credibility to my understanding of the issues facing the city and my strong desire to serve as a councilman at large."

While Strongsville has experienced rapid growth, Zubek said, council leadership has neglected to act on a variety of issues which impact residents.

"The lack of leadership and concern that the incumbent candidates have shown for the citizens of Strongsville can be seen in the lack of a cable public access channel that is being paid for by cable user fees and could be budgeted from commissions paid to the city by the two cable operations," Zubek said. "It can be seen in the Ice Rink black hole that, through March 2005, has cost the city \$749,000 and in the 1996 Comprehensive Plan which, had it been given a positive vote in 1996, 1997, 1998 or 1999, might have altered the present development plans for the North Howe Road area."

Elections will be held on November 8, 2005.
