Angel House Center for Art and Creative Life Change will present *Creativity in Bloom*, a free open house featuring art and music, exploring life, spirituality and higher consciousness, on Earth Day, Sunday, April 22, 2007, from 1:00 to 4:00 p.m.

The informal program will feature the music of local singer/songwriter Christopher Reynolds, an art exhibit by Cindy Farmer, the poetry of Dr. Jane Piirto and readings from the latest book by trance prophet Dr. Michael Olin Hitt. Author Laura George will discuss her new book, *Excuse Me, Your Job is Waiting*.

Appropriately set during the season of renewal, the event will herald the latest works of the participating artists.

"This is really what Angel House is all about," said Carol Dombrose, executive director of Angel House. "The program focuses on spirituality through art, music and words and I'm thrilled to have such accomplished artists taking part in this celebration."

Reynolds a teacher at Berea High School and Ashland University, will release his 11th CD, *The Age of Magnification: The Highway Home*, at the event. A singer and guitarist, Reynolds wages creativity through his Unrealist art movement, a spiritual philosophy that connects ecological awareness, consciousness of higher beings and a cosmology that embraces ancient mysticism.

Cindy Farmer, a visionary artist from Copley, Ohio will open a weeklong exhibit of her latest project, *Exploring Life, Spirituality and Higher Consciousness Through Art*. The exhibit features 12 colored pencil drawings that contain overlapping images, word graphics and sacred geometric patterns that link science and spirituality.

"The drawings explore questions that many of us have, such as where did we come from and what happens when we die," said Farmer, owner of The Art Barn Studio, in Copley.

At the open house, Farmer and Reynolds will merge visual and musical creation by "answering" each other's work through their own artistic genres.

Dr. Jane Piirto, is a poet, essayist and a professor at Ashland University who has collaborated with Reynolds in setting poetry to music. Piirto will recite passages of her work at the event.

Michael Olin Hitt, is an English professor at Mount Union College and the husband of a United Methodist minister. Olin Hitt said he received the gift of prophecy and began to speak with the voice of a maggid, or Messenger of the Holy Spirit. His

soon-to-be-released book, *Word of God upon My Lips*, describes his journey to integrate his gift of prophecy and includes answers to some of the questions on the hearts of today's people of faith. He is the founder of the Spiritual Quest Foundation.

Laura George will be on hand to discuss her new release, *Excuse Me, Your Job is Waiting*. In the book, available at Border and Barnes & Noble, George applies the powerful Law of Attraction to the life experiences of both losing and getting a job, suggesting ways to flip the negative feelings you may be carrying about your job search.

Dombrose, a certified psychotherapist, counselor, writer and healer, will give a presentation about the importance of creativity to wholeness.

The program will include a silent auction.

Angel House, a non-profit organization, is a tranquility base for people seeking to explore their own spirituality through art. Set on a peaceful ridge overlooking the Rocky River, Angel House offers educational programs and classes that foster growth and health in mind, body and spirit and assists individuals in using their creative energy to fulfill their potential. It provides a place for people to explore their creativity and use their energy in a positive way for the betterment of the community.
